

Are Kendall Children Ready for Kindergarten?

Illinois rates kindergarten readiness in three developmental areas:

- Math
- Language and Literacy
- Social and Emotional Development


As of the 2022-23 school year, only 21% of children in Kendall County are kindergarten-ready in all three areas, compared to 30% statewide.



High-quality childcare makes a difference.

ExceleRate Illinois is the state's quality rating system for licensed child care, helping families find high-quality options. Programs are rated as Bronze, Silver, and Gold, with Gold being the highest.

In 2022, only 14% of licensed childcare programs were rated Bronze, Silver, or Gold, and the majority received a Silver rating.
