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### OUR STORY

The **Plano Area Alliance Supporting Student Success (PAASSS)** has officially launched the **Grundy-Kendall Integrated Referral and Intake System (IRIS) Network**, connecting local agencies to streamline family referrals and strengthen coordination across the region. IRIS is a secure, web-based tool that helps service providers make and track referrals, ensuring families receive **warm handoffs**, faster access to services, and better continuity of care.

Partners from Region 24 continue our mission with 18 family referrals facilitated, with **successfully closed**. The network now includes 50 partner agencies in Grundy and Kendall Counties.

### OUR VISION

To support families in Region 24, community partners will work together to build a supportive, accessible, and inclusive system where all families have resources that they need to thrive in their community.

### REGION 24 IS OFF TO A GREAT START!

This quarter, our network grew to **46 partners**, welcoming **six new partners** and maintaining strong engagement with **16 partners actively using the IRIS System**. Partners in the education sector led referral activity, with **Grundy County seeing the highest volume**, while the network continued to meet community standards with an **average response time of 4.3 days**. collaboration across sectors remained strong in connecting families to needed supports. Great work Region 24!

### MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION

Multifactor authentication (MFA) has officially launched as of January 21, 2026, to better protect your data! All users will complete a one-time setup using an authenticator app on a mobile device, with a quick verification code required once per week. ### CROSS-SECTOR REFERRAL GROWTH – A HISTORY OF COLLABORATION

The first 100 IRIS referrals occurred in the Southeast Kansas IRIS network during the initial piloting of the system. During three months in early 2017, four Resource Navigation organizations made 100 referrals to three Early Childhood and one Maternal and Child Health organization. This initial adoption, driven by a resilient and collaborative spirit, established the path for other regions to develop their own IRIS networks.

### ELEVATOR SPEECH

*The Integrated Referral and Intake System (IRIS) is a secure, web-based system that helps community organizations connect families to the right services—and track what happens next. The PAASS Grundy/Kendall IRIS Network provides a space for real-time, HIPAA-compliant referrals, ensuring agencies respond within five business days and families don't fall through the cracks.*
